However, technical knowledge is not the only thing employers consider. Being responsible, adaptable and willing to learn can also make a difference. People may need to learn new skills several times during their careers.

Preparing for the future does not mean choosing one profession and never changing. It means understanding your interests, developing useful abilities and being ready to adapt to new situations.

HOW AI IS CHANGING OUR ROUTINE

Artificial intelligence is becoming part of everyday life. Many people use AI tools without even realizing it. Recommendation systems on streaming platforms, virtual assistants, translation apps and navigation tools are examples of technologies that use artificial intelligence.

In education, AI can help students organize information, review content and practice different skills. It can also support teachers when planning activities or adapting materials. However, these tools should be used carefully.

One important challenge is checking whether the information provided by AI is correct. Artificial intelligence can make mistakes, present incomplete information or reproduce inaccurate content. For this reason, users need to compare sources and think critically before accepting an answer.

AI can be useful, but it should not replace human judgment. Responsible use means understanding both the benefits and the limitations of this technology.

Responsible digital behavior also includes understanding that online actions can have consequences. Comments, photos and messages can affect other people and may remain available for a long time. For this reason, respect and critical thinking are essential when using digital spaces.
